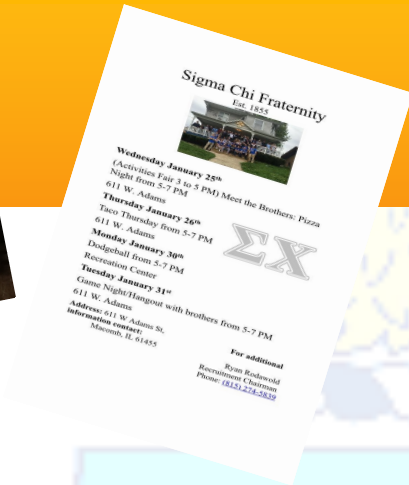


SIGMA CHI AT IOTA OMICRON
