PADDLE SWAP

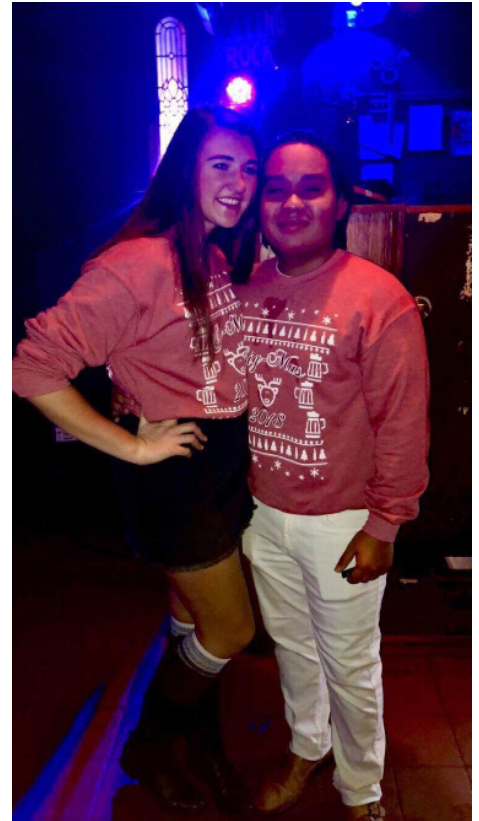


At the end of November the active chapter participated in a paddle swap with our new neighbors, Delta Zeta. Following we had our first of many socials to come at the Place to Be.



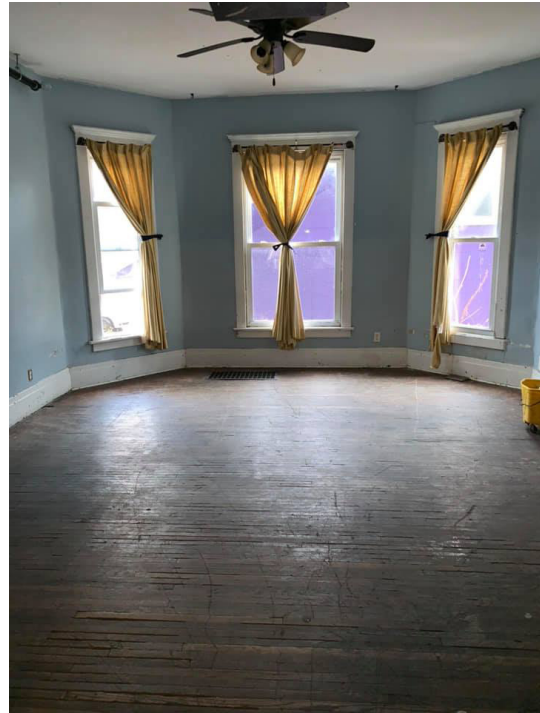
SIGMAS

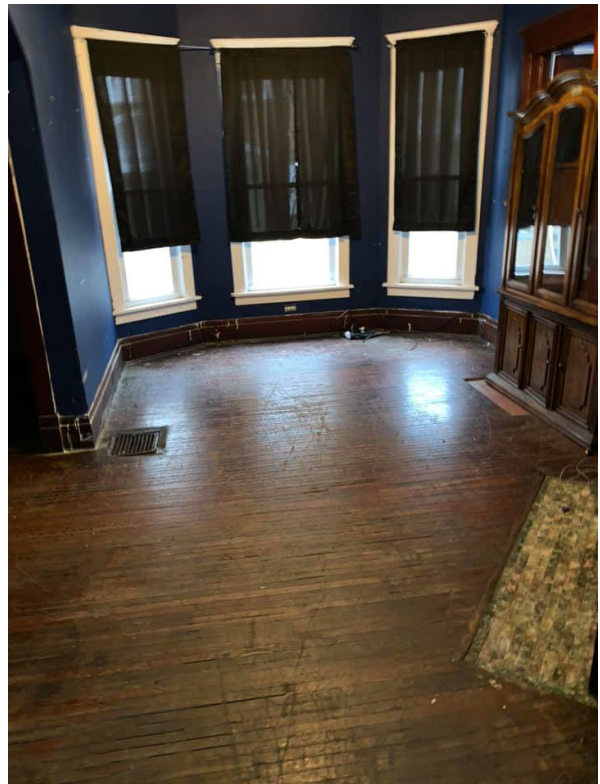


WORK WEEKEND

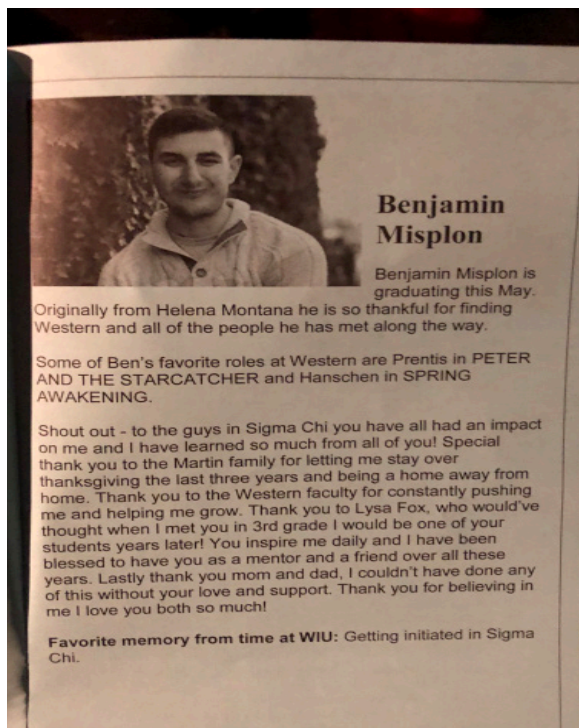


BROSGIVING
